New 4-H projects make their debut at the 2021 Fillmore County Fair

What is more exciting than watching 4-Hers show their animals or checking out 4-H projects? This year Fillmore County Fair attendees will have a chance to check out the talents of Fillmore County cake decorators and watch 4-Hers show their dogs.

"Fillmore County 4-H is excited to offer many new projects this year, including the Dog Project and Cake Decorating," explained Kayla Biel, Interim Extension Educator, 4-H Youth Development, Fillmore County.

Dogs

Fillmore County 4-Hers have been

spending their free time learning how to train and show their dog at the fair, and they hope fairgoers will attend the dog show at the county fair on Saturday, July 31, beginning at 9 a.m. Everyone is welcome to come and see what the project is all about!

"The Dog Project is making a comeback after not being offered for many years in the county. As a result, 4-Hers can take part in obedience and showmanship. These youth often practice together with their dogs to navigate obstacle courses, practice obedience, and have a great time," explained Biel.

Brother and sister Christian and Amarissa Ladd will be showing Luna, a 2-yearold Doberman, and 5-year-old Tater, a

The siblings explained, "They officially were enrolled last year, but we didn't have a show due to COVID. So instead, we had practices, a project fundraiser, and a fun show with prizes."

Why did you sign up for the dog project? Christian explained, "My mom was involved in the dog project when she was in 4-H, and I wanted to try it too." Amarissa thought, "It sounded like a fun thing to do with Tater. I'm looking forward to doing agility!"

Both brother and sister have attended 4-H sponsored workshops. Christian explained, "We work on parts of the dog, obedience and showmanship patterns, and how to pose your dog for showmanship." Photo submitted

Amarissa explained, "Yes, we have been having classes once a week since early June. I have learned obedience. Heeling, sit/stay, patterns like the triangle one in showmanship, posing my dog, parts of my dog, and how to answer questions about Tater's breed, what AKC means, the different breed groups. Stuff like that."

Both Christian and Amarissa explained that their mom is a dog trainer, so they have had the luxury of helping her since they were little.

Christian learned "how stubborn my dog is, and how much fun it is to be involved in the dog project. Just because Luna has been trained does not mean she has the same respect for me as she does for my mom. My working relationship with Luna is an ongoing process." Amarissa learned about the parts of her dog (anatomy) and showmanship.

Want to spend time with your dog? Both Christian and Amarissa recommending signing up for the dog project next year, as it is fun, and you get to bond with your dog. Christian mentioned, "They get candy for answering questions right!"

Cake Decorating

A delicious tasting new project is Cake Decorating. Did the 4-Hers learn to lick their fingers and the bowl and beaters?

"Cake Decorating is a new event for the whole state of Minnesota, along with Fillmore County. The contest took place on June 30. First, participants made and decorated a cake or cupcakes to their liking. Then, they were judged on their knowledge of the process, consistency, appearance, and taste of their work," shared Biel.

The 4-H Premium Book describes the reward of learning how to decorate a cake, "When you bake and decorate a cake for a special occasion, the smiling faces around the table will be your greatest reward. After a few lessons and a

lot of practice, you will be able to decorate beautiful cakes for birthday parties, anniversaries, and other special days. You can practice on practice boards, waxed paper or freezer paper (waxed side up) taped to cardboard — or even a cake pan turned upside down. Once you decorate the practice surface, scrape the icing off and use it over again."

4-Hers can create theme cakes for birthdays, weddings, or other special events or creative cakes such as animals, cars/trucks, food, or traditional cakes such as traditional wedding cakes, cakes with borders, flowers, and fancy tips.


