

Kids Power Wheel Demo Derby

2024 Fillmore County Fair

Saturday, July 20th, 2024 @ 6:00 pm

The Derby is designed as an unusual spectator attraction. Every entrant is subject to the following rules and regulations in the interest of safety and equal competition. The Fillmore County Fair does not imply or guarantee safety. Total responsibility for the inspection of the car and rule compliance is by the owner/driver, not the Fillmore County Fair. Final inspection will occur 10 minutes prior to Kids Power Wheel Demo Derby. Judge's decision is final. **This is supposed to be FUN for the kids, parents PLEASE don't ruin it for them!**

Driver's Rules

1. Judges can rule that kids won't participate if there are modifications to the car more than those allowed that are stated below!
2. Kids 3-10 years of age may participate. All kids must be accompanied by an adult.
3. All drivers must supply their own car and set it up according to the rules.
4. When choosing a Power Wheels for your kid, please keep in mind these vehicles will be running into each other (like bumper cars or derby cars). The Power Wheels needs to be the kind the kid sits IN, not ON. NO 4-WHEELERS, TRACTORS, MOTORCYCLES!
5. Driver only. No passengers.
6. Derby is limited to 6 to 12-volt power wheels ONLY! Motors must remain stock. No connecting multiple batteries together.
7. A seat belt is recommended but not required.
8. No added reinforcements for strength.
9. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties or duct tape (or other flexible products) to make them stay shut.
10. Stock tires only. No screws in tires, no chains, etc. Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking, nothing else.
11. They must be the stock height that came from the store.
12. The vehicle is allowed to have UP TO a 12-volt lawn mower or motorcycle battery. Battery cannot be mounted in the passenger seat, and the battery must be secured and sealed away from the kid. No connecting multiple batteries together.
13. Decorative changes can be made to the Power Wheels to make it look like a derby car; however, there can be no reinforcement to the Power Wheels. Changes and additions can ONLY be decorative. i.e.: header pipes sticking up, painting the car, etc.
14. Helmets are mandatory; bicycle helmets are permitted.
15. Shoes or sneakers required. NO sandals.
16. Any situation that arises, Chairman has the power to add or change rules as required. If it isn't in the rules, it doesn't make it legal.
17. All kids and Power Wheels must be at the Fillmore County Fairgrounds by 6:00 pm 7/20/2024 for final registration. Please bring Power Wheels to the east entrance to the grandstand arena (where cars enter from the pits).
18. All kids must have a signed Consent form and Entry form from a parent or guardian at Fillmore County Fair Board Office by 7/20/2024 @ 5:30 pm. Forms are available at Fillmore County Fair Board Office during fair or online at www.fillmorecountyfair.com
19. This event is free for your kid to participate in, you are responsible to pay for fair parking and grandstand admittance.
20. Maximum 30 entries. All participants receive a bragging trophy.

2. I understand that the ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT(S) ARE VERY DANGEROUS AND INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF MY BEING SERIOUSLY INJURED OR HURT, MY BEING PARALYZED OR KILLED.
3. I know that these risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or in-actions, the actions or in-actions of others participating in the event(s), the rules of the event(s), the condition and layout of the premises and equipment, and/or the **NEGLIGENCE** of others, including those persons responsible for conducting the event(s).
4. I HEREBY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, EVEN IF THE RISKS ARE CREATED BY THE **NEGLIGENCE** of the promoter, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations, or any of its subdivisions, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any restricted areas, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners, and lessees of premises used to conduct the event(s), premises or event(s) directions, or instructions, or engages in risk evaluation, loss control activities or sales regarding the premises or event(s), and each of them, their directors, officers, agents, employees, representatives, owners, members, affiliates, successors and assigns, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releasees".
5. I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE, AND DISCHARGE, ALL OF THE RELEASEES FROM ALL LIABILITY TO ME, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, for any and all loss or damage and any claim or any demand on account of any injury to me including, but not limited to, my death, whether caused by the **NEGLIGENCE** of the Releasees or otherwise.
